



VOTING MATTERS!

TO REGISTER BY MAIL

Get the voter registration form. Call the county elections office (925-335-7800) or call 1-800-345-VOTE (8683) to have a form sent to you. To be sent multiple forms call the State Elections Division and they will send them to you (916-657-2166). Fill out the form.

- Mark the boxes to indicate you're a US citizen and will be 18 by Election Day, Nov 8
- Provide your full name
- Provide your address. If you don't have a street address, use the space to describe where you live.
- Provide your mailing address, if different from above
- Provide your birthday
- Provide the state (or foreign country) where you were born
- Provide your California driver's license number or state ID card number. If you don't have either of these, provide the last four digits of your social security number if you have one.
- (Optional) provide your email address
- (Optional) provide your phone number
- Provide your political party preference, or check the box to indicate you don't have a political party preference
- (Optional) If you want to receive a ballot to vote by mail instead of at the polls on election day, initial the space provided
- If you're reporting a change in name, address, or political party, provide your previous information
- Sign and date the form
- If you're registering for the first time in California, include a copy of a photo ID, utility bill, bank statement, government check, paycheck, or other government document that shows your name and address
- If you don't submit the ID with your application, you'll have to show ID when you vote

Send in the form

- **Mail the form by Oct 24** (for the November 2016 election) to the county elections office:
 - **Registrar of Voters, P.O. Box 271, Martinez, CA 94553** (you may put a label over the Secretary of State address on the form); **OR**
 - **Bring in your form to 555 Escobar Street, Martinez** **OR**
 - **Mail in your form to the Secretary of State** **OR**
